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Amy R. DeFelice, MD, is an Associate Professor of Clinical Pediatrics in the Division of Pediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition at Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons. Dr. DeFelice directs the Nutrition Support Service at NewYork-Presbyterian/Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital, is Co-director of the Division's fellowship program, and serves on the Quality Assurance Committee of the Hospital.

In addition to maintaining a general pediatric gastroenterology practice, Dr. DeFelice specializes in celiac disease and the nutritional management of patients with cystic fibrosis. Dr. DeFelice lectures extensively on the subject of celiac disease and is a member of Columbia's Celiac Disease Center. Her other clinical interests include failure to thrive, enteral tube feeding, parenteral nutrition, and inflammatory bowel disease.

Dr. DeFelice pursued her internship and residency at Beth Israel Medical Center, where she was chief resident from 1985 to 1986. The following year she went on to pursue a fellowship in pediatric gastroenterology, hepatology and nutrition at Columbia University Medical Center. She has served as a full-time faculty member at Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital since 1990.
