Nadia Ovchinsky, MD, MBA, is a pediatric gastroenterologist whose clinical and research interests relate to pediatric liver disease, health outcomes of pediatric liver transplantation, metabolic disorders of childhood affecting the liver and intestinal tract, as well as medical rehabilitation for children with intestinal failure and intestinal failure associated with liver disease. Dr. Ovchinsky, Assistant Professor of Clinical Pediatrics at Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons, also directs pediatric resident and medical student education in the Division of Pediatric Gastroenterology and Hepatology.

Dr. Ovchinsky received a master's degree in business administration from Rutgers University in 2001, followed by her medical degree at Robert Wood Johnson Medical School in 2002. From 2002 to 2005, Dr. Ovchinsky trained as an intern and chief resident at NewYork-Presbyterian/Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital, Columbia University Medical Center, where she also completed a fellowship in pediatric gastroenterology in 2009.
