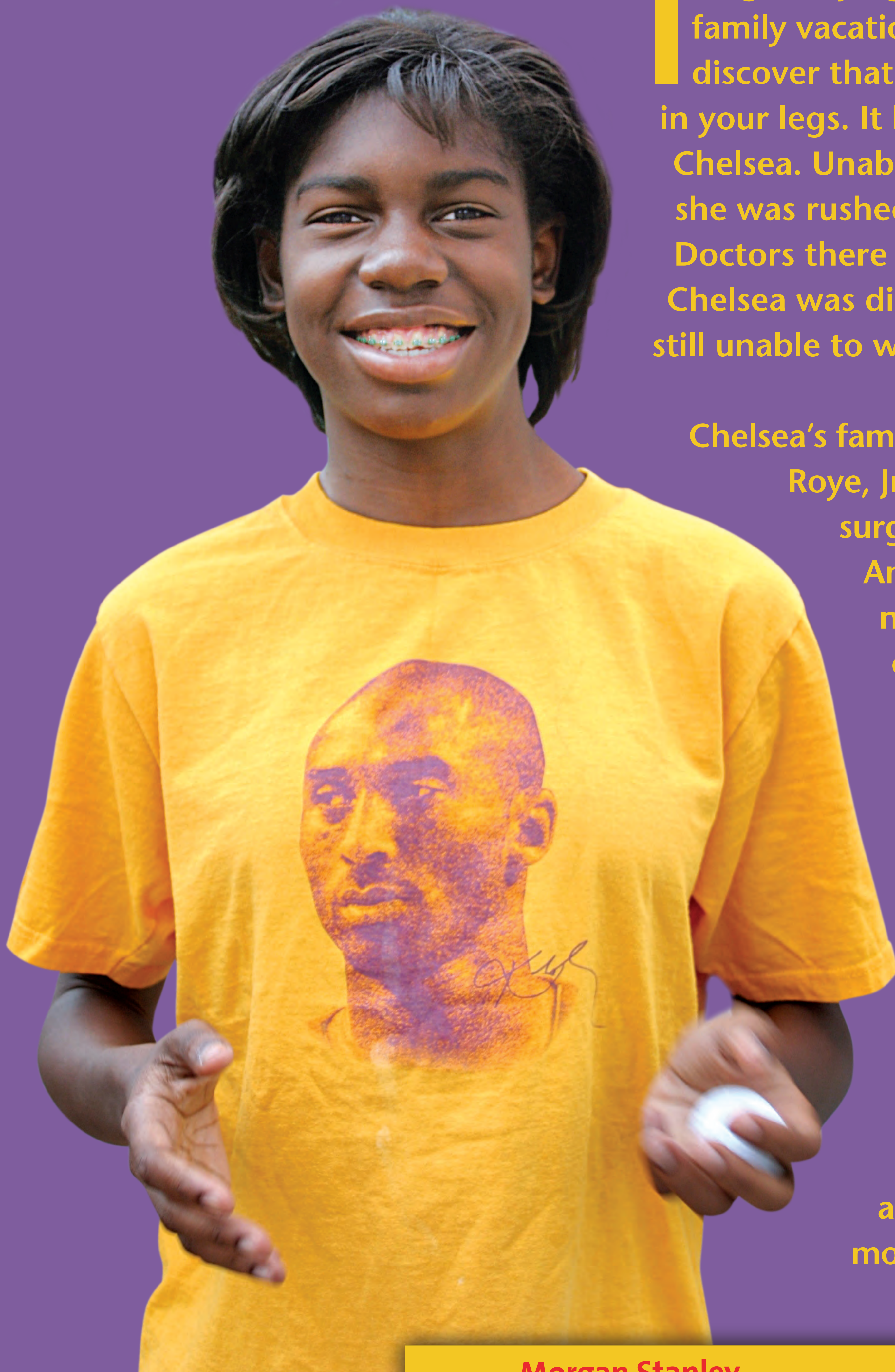


CHELSEA BOUNCES BACK



Imagine flying home from a great family vacation and upon landing, you discover that you have lost all feeling in your legs. It happened to 14-year-old Chelsea. Unable to walk off of the plane, she was rushed to a nearby hospital. Doctors there had no answers, so Chelsea was discharged in a wheelchair still unable to walk.

Chelsea's family turned to Dr. David P. Roye, Jr. pediatric orthopaedic surgeon and Dr. Richard C.E. Anderson, a pediatric neurosurgeon, who quickly discovered that the paraplegia was being caused by Chelsea's scoliosis. After a complex 10-hour surgery, Chelsea's relief was immediate, and she was back at home and walking in just four days. With physical therapy, she was able to return to school where she was making high honors and playing golf one short month after surgery.
